

How to get to Rhoserchan from Aberystwyth

Leaving Aberystwyth on the A487, heading North towards Machynlleth, drive up Penglais hill past Hospital, National Library and University on your right.

After approximately 2 miles, turn Right along B road signposted Penrhyncoch.

Cross narrow humpbacked bridge, and ford.

At crossroads go straight on, continuing on B road, driving past Aberystwyth University.

Enter Penrhyncoch, continue until you arrive at the Welsh flag and War Memorial, and **turn right, off the B road, into the centre of the village.**

Bear left and drive through the village, passing a Garage, Church and School on your left. Leaving the village, continue driving uphill, passing a bus depot on your left.

Stay on this road, round some nasty bends, ignore a turning to your right, and keep going uphill (towards Ponterwyd).

Pass cluster of houses on your left, named Penrhiwnedd, drive onwards and upwards. Road narrows and becomes single track, keep straight on, passing two white houses on your left.

Not far after these you will see forestry trees ahead and a grey farm house on your right.

Turn left down the stony track directly opposite this house. Stay on this track, going downhill and bearing always to the left, until you arrive in the car park (½ mile).

The First Stage Rhoserchan building is in front of you, down the steps: the Second Stage farmhouse, Tŷ Rhoserchan, is to your right within its own garden.

For First Stage Reception walk over the wooden bridge into the glass reception area.

Total distance from Aberystwyth is 8 miles, and Penrhyncoch is half way.
For journey time allow 20-25 minutes.
